

Following the classroom training an opportunity was given for all the students to have 'hands on' experience in the use of various fire extinguishers..The activity was carried out on a fire ground set up on the College car park. At all times the students were kept in a safe position and both they and the College were free from concern as to their safety and that of others in the vicinity.

At the end of the session Mr Hall gave a brief talk on fire safety in the home.

Follow Up- Within days of the course Mr Hall provided the College with 'certificates of attendance' for all the students who took part. A course evaluation sheet was given out by the College and the comments received from the students (including those who already had some experience) clearly showed that they had both enjoyed the course and had learnt a great deal.
